CLAYTON'S ADVISORY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

Board of Adjustment: Considers applications for variations to the City's Zoning ordinance.

BOCA Board of Appeals: Hears appeals from property owners regarding the interpretation of the International Building and Fire Codes.

City Plan Commission/Architectural Review Board: Advises the Board of Aldermen on all requests for rezoning, resubdivisions, site plan approval, and conditional use permits. Reviews developments for compatibility with the architectural standards established by the City.

Clayton Art Commission: Supports a process for incorporating artist services and art works into the City of Clayton; defines policies and guidelines for acquiring and commissioning art; and promotes the acquisition, maintenance, and upkeep of works of art on sites within the City.

Clayton Recreation, Sports and Wellness Commission: Oversees the operation of The Center of Clayton, a joint use athletic/recreational facility owned by the City of Clayton and Clayton School District.

Ecology and Environmental Awareness Committee: Develops and supports ecologically sound programs and practices for Clayton's municipal government, the Clayton community and the metropolitan St. Louis region.

Economic Development Advisory Committee: Recommends the use of funds collected within the Special Business District; and makes recommendations regarding significant matters related to the vitality of the Clayton business community.

Industrial Development Authority: Provides tax-exempt financing to eligible industrial and manufacturing facilities in accordance with federal and state tax laws.

Non-Uniformed Employees Retirement: Serves as plan administrator of the non-uniformed employees retirement pension plan.

Parks and Recreation Commission: Advises the Board of Aldermen on programs and facilities designed to promote recreational opportunities for all residents of the community.

Strategic Issues Committee: Determines and prioritizes strategic issues with which the City is faced and periodically prepares a strategic plan for the Board of Aldermen.

Uniformed Employees Retirement Board: Administers the uniformed employees pension plan for sworn Police and Fire personnel.
