EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COMMAND AND CONTROL

I. PURPOSE.

To establish a well-defined order of succession governing command and control of the City's emergency management program. This also includes the integration of the Incident Command System into the process as the primary operations management system.

II. ORDER OF SUCCESSION.

In accordance with Chapter 6 of the Code of Ordinances and the City's Emergency Operations Plan, the following order of succession has been established to designate the managerial positions responsible for command of emergency management operations:

1. Chief of Police - Emergency Management Director
2. Fire Chief - Deputy Emergency Management Director.
3. Ranking Police or Fire Commander designated as Incident Commander.
