PATROL AREAS/BOUNDARIES

I. PURPOSE.

To provide a general guideline for the deployment of patrol assets within the city, consistent with established geographical boundaries.

II. FOUR DISTRICT ALIGNMENT.

On a normal basis, the city is subdivided into four separate patrol areas. These are designated as 1901 through 1904.

A. District #1

This shall be the easternmost patrol area within the city and shall be bounded by the city limits on the east (commencing with the 6300 series of address numbers), the northern edge of Forsyth Boulevard to the north, the center of Clayton Road on the south, and the center of Big Bend Boulevard on the west.

This shall include the Demun/Hi-Pointe subdivision, Hillcrest subdivision, Wydown Forest subdivision, Tuscany Park subdivision, Concordia Seminary, Fontbonne University, the Washington University dormitory area, Wydown Middle School, Captain Elementary School, and the Forsyth School.

B. District #2

Located in the east-central section of the city, this shall be bounded by the center of Big Bend Boulevard to the east, the city limits running along the northern edge of the Brentmoor and Carswold subdivisions and continuing along Forest Park Parkway to the north, the city limits running east and west along the center stripe of Clayton Road to the south, and the center of Brentwood Boulevard to the west.

This patrol area shall include the Southmoor subdivision, Ridgemoor subdivision, East Brentmoor Park subdivision, West Brentmoor Park subdivision, Carswold subdivision, Claverach Park subdivision, Moorlands subdivision, Polo subdivision, Wydown Forest subdivision, Davis Place subdivision, Oak Knoll Park, Glenridge Elementary school, and Meramec Elementary school.

C. District #3

Shall be bounded on the east in the 7400 Blk by University City and on the south by Forest Park Parkway to Brentwood Blvd. The boundary will then run north and south along the center line of Brentwood to Clayton Road. The district will also be bounded on the north by the center line of Forsyth Blvd and on the west by the Ladue city limits just west of I-170.

This district shall include the majority of the Central Business District, Clayshire subdivision, Haddington Court subdivision, part of Tanglewood subdivision, Shaw Park and Clayton High School.

D. District #4

Located in the northernmost section of the city, this district is bounded by University City to the east and north (the 7400 block and 300 blks respectively). Its also bordered by the City of Ladue on the west and the center line of Forsyth Blvd and Maryland Avenue to the south.

This will include the northern section of the Central Business District, Old Town subdivision, Clayton Gardens subdivision, Gay Field and Taylor Park.

Officers assigned to these areas should primarily remain within the established boundaries of their respective patrol sectors though some overlap between areas is to be expected. Officers may also be directed to handle out-of-district assignments by ECDC, provide assistance to other police units, or be required to leave their area for a number of legitimate duty reasons.

Officers assigned as extra patrol units will generally fall into two categories. The first will carry a designator as extra car east or west. The east unit will patrol all areas east of Hanley Road (District #1 and #2) while the west unit will patrol all areas west of Hanley Road (District #3 and #4). The second variation will carry a designator as an at-large car. This unit will be permitted to roam throughout the city at their own discretion.

Should circumstances dictate the necessity to alter the four district configuration to three patrol districts, the patrol areas will be numbered District #1 through District #3.

III. THREE DISTRICT ALIGNMENT.

A. District #1

This area shall be the easternmost patrol district and will be bounded by St. Louis on the east (at the 6300 series of numbers), University City on the north, Richmond Heights on the south marked by the center line of Clayton Road, and Audubon Drive north to the boundary between Carswold and West Brentmoor subdivisions on the west.

B. District #2

District #2 will be bounded by Audubon Drive and the boundary between Carswold and West Brentmoor on the east, Forest Park Parkway on the north, the center of Clayton Road to the south, and the Ladue city limits on the west.

C. District #3

District #3 will be bounded by the University City limits in the 7400 Blk on the east, University City on the north, the southern edge of the right-a-way of Forest Park Parkway to the south (with the exception of a small grouping of homes on Bland Avenue) and the Ladue city limits on the west.
