



## COMPOSTABLE GUIDE

Compostable Material means materials that could be put back into the ground to make soil, mulch or fertilizer that can then be used in a garden or around the home.

### PERMITTED INGREDIENTS SHALL INCLUDE:

- Yard waste, including sod, leaves & grass clippings
- Wood chips & sawdust
- Vegetables, fruits & their remains, including peels & rinds
- Straw
- Empty egg shells
- Aquatic weeds
- Evergreen needles
- Hair
- Dryer lint
- Coffee grounds & tea leaves
- Vacuum cleaner dust
- Organic garden waste
- Commercial compost additives

### ITEMS NOT PERMITTED:

- Animal carcasses, fish, fowl, meat, bones or any other animal products
- Manure
- Used litter box remains
- Milk, cheese, sour cream or other dairy products
- Lard, oils or oil-based foods
- Mayonnaise
- Salad Dressing
- Whole grains (rice, wheat, barley, etc.)
- Peanut Butter
- Items not normally composted
- Items not biodegradable
