



## HANLEY HOUSE PORCHES

Location: Hanley House, 7600 Westmoreland Ave.

Martin Franklin Hanley built the Historic Hanley House in 1855. The farmstead is the oldest structure in the City of Clayton and it is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The restored home is now an historic house museum filled with original family furnishings, artifacts, and letters that together represent an honest portrayal of 19th century Missouri life. In order to preserve this historic gem, the Hanley House porches needed to be replaced. This improvement project also presented the opportunity to add an ADA accessible ramp to the back porch. This project was supported by Susan Hanley, the Robert J. Trulaske Family Foundation, and Oliver and Mary Langenberg,. This project was completed in 2013.
