



HANLEY PARK PAVILION

Location: Hanley Park, 7600 Westmoreland Ave.

Martin Franklin Hanley built the Historic Hanley House in 1855. The farmstead is the oldest structure in the City of Clayton and it is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The pavilion features a covered seating area which is used as an outdoor classroom when students come for tours. The pavilion also includes storage space and handicap accessible restrooms. This project was made possible through a grant from the St. Louis Municipal Park Grant Commission. This project was completed in 2012.
