ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 400 OF THE CLAYTON CITY CODE PERTAINING TO THE CLAYTON PLAN COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2025, the people of Clayton amended their City Charter to, among other things, update and simplify administrative and procedural provisions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to effectuate and implement the changes adopted by Clayton’s residents as hereinafter provided; and

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 14 of the Clayton Charter provides that the city council by ordinance may create, change, and abolish offices, departments, boards, commissions, or agencies other than those established by the charter, and by ordinance may assign additional functions or duties to offices, departments, boards, commissions, or agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CLAYTON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

Section 400.060, of Chapter 400 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Clayton, Missouri, is hereby repealed and a new Section 400.060 is hereby enacted in lieu thereof to read as follows:

CHAPTER 400. Planning, City Plan Commission, and Architectural Review Board

SECTION 400.060. Constitution of Commission

There shall be a city plan commission consisting of seven (7) members appointed by the city council, one (1) of whom shall be a member of the city council appointed annually. The other six members shall be residents of the city qualified by knowledge or experience to act on questions pertaining to the development and administration of a city plan, who shall be appointed for terms of three (3) years, except that of the members first (1st) appointed, two (2) shall be appointed to serve for one (1) year, two (2) for two (2) years and one (1) for three (3) years. The city council shall fill vacancies for any unexpired term. The plan commission shall elect its own chairman and other officers annually.

Section 2.

The Chapter, Article, Division and/or Section assignments designated in this Ordinance may be revised and altered in the process of recodifying or servicing the City's Code of Ordinances upon supplementation of such code if, in the discretion of the editor, an alternative designation would be

more reasonable. In adjusting such designations, the editor may also change other designations and numerical assignment of code sections to accommodate such changes.

Section 3.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that each and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, section and subsection hereof and that the City Council intends to adopt each said part, section and subsection separately and independently of any other part, section and subsection. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections and subsections shall be and remain in full force and effect.

Section 4.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect both from and after its passage by the City Council.
